

## 2012 West Sauvignon Blanc

2012 West Sauvignon Blanc is a fresh and crisp wine with structured mouth feel and a long finish. It starts with aromas of citrus and melon and continues on the palate with the same flavors accompanied by green apple. You can pair this wine with appetizers, salads, fish and seafood or just sip it by itself.

West Wines is a family owned winery in Dry Creek Valley, Sonoma County. Our winemaking style is inspired by French winemaking and we have been exporting wine to Europe since 2004. We believe in responsible agricultural practices such as minimizing the use of energy and water and using solar power. We use cover crops between our vine rows to create nutrition for the plants but also flowers who serve as a habitat for beneficial insects for pest control.
