2013 West Sauvignon Blanc is a fresh and crisp wine with aromas of gooseberry and green melon which continue on the palate in addition to mineral tones and well balanced acidity. You can pair this wine with appetizers, salads, fish and seafood or just sip it by itself.

West Wines is a family owned winery in Dry Creek Valley, Sonoma County. We started growing grapes 1998 and continued into winemaking where we favor a French style. We sell in the US and have been exporting to Europe since 2004. We believe in responsible agricultural practices such as minimizing the use of energy and water and using solar power. We use cover crops between our vine rows to create nutrition for the plants but also flowers who serve as a habitat for beneficial insects for pest control.
